"Can you help me to not have an abortion?"

Marie went on to say that her doctors were **pressuring** her to abort the baby in her womb because of potential birth defects. Already a mother of 5, Marie was determined to parent, and she needed someone who would stand with her to say that **ALL lives have value**, including baby Leylah! Crossroads staff offered Marie emotional and spiritual support throughout her pregnancy, delivery and even today.

After birth, Baby Leylah was officially diagnosed with Trisomy 18, a diagnosis often paired with dim prospects on life expectancy and quality. Despite being underestimated at every turn with surgeons refusing to perform needed surgeries, she has defied the odds in her first year of life!

As they continue to fight for their baby, Marie and her husband often say to each other, "If Leylah wasn't here, what would we be doing? This is how our life is supposed to be and it is perfect!"

When women seek help here, they're welcomed into the Crossroads family. Crossroads strives to provide help that reaches beyond pregnancy resources and touches the woman's soul. 20 years of Ministry

With the blessing of Bishop Oscar A. Solis, pastor of the St. Joseph Co-Cathedral at the time, and the cooperation of devoted parishioners, Crossroads Pregnancy Resource Center (CPRC) was carefully and intentionally launched in 2003.

Founding member, Alida Cochran, reflecting on the origins of CPRC said, "With the closest crisis pregnancy center located over an hour away, our area needed a physical place where women and girls could get the confidential, non-judgmental help they needed from individuals who understood the specific care they needed."

Over the last 20 years, Crossroads Pregnancy Resource Center has served more than **4,000 women**.

"Simply put, God has protected and provided for Crossroads all along," said Cochran. "The ministry serves our community in a mighty way and is at its best now and will only continue to grow. I am continuously impressed by board membership and devoted staff who carefully maintain this organization."

When asked about her hopes for the next 20 years, Cochran said, "I pray that God will continue to show us how to best serve the women who need our services the most. I also pray that more and more women and men choose abstinence, but when faced with an unplanned pregnancy, that Crossroads will be there for them."






